Scandinavia's number one logistics city

When it comes to logistics, Gothenburg – with its central location – is without a doubt number one in Scandinavia.

In other words, it is not by chance that DB Schenker, DHL Express, Postnord TPL, Rajapack and Dawa Däck are among the companies that have chosen Airport City Göteborg as the place for their logistics centres.

Logistics Park 1, Airport City Göteborg's first logistics park, with 150,000 square metres of space for warehouse and logistics operations, is already fully leased and will be completed in 2020.

Logistics Park 2 is in the planning stage. A detailed plan will be prepared to enable the development of another approximately 350,000 square metres of logistics premises, with construction expected to begin in 2023.

Development is under way here for a major logistics and operations area, combining large-scale construction with nature and green areas.

Building Airport City Göteborg is a long-term undertaking. We are sensitive to the surroundings and are creating an area where modern architecture will meet incredible nature.
